

Putting Competition Check List if hosted.

This is a list for you as the Master of Ceremonies (MC) to make sure that you adhere to all the conditions for the putting competition.

Rules:

- Four players are nominated to take part in the putting competition at the end of the event.
- Only players participating in the event are eligible.
- Players can be determined either by a lucky draw or normally the four players closest to the pin on the par 3's will qualify. (If one player is closest on more than one hole he/she is only allowed to attempt their put once.)
- Put to me made from 20m on the putting green.
- The players that are not putting must turn their back on the person attempting the put so not to read the speed and slope of the put.
- All putting attempts must be recorded by the MC. Person recording to stand behind the putter and track the ball to the hole.

Suggested Process to follow:

- The MC and sponsor decides when after the last four ball have finished to host the putting competition.
- MC determine the 20m distance and marks the spot from where the puts must be made on the green with two tees.
- All players and guests are invited down to the putting green.
- The MC announces the four candidates that will attempt the R5000 put and call them forward.
- MC goes through the rules with the nominated players and the guests.
- Every player attempts the put.
